ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

FALL, SUMMER	Priority: November 1; Final: February 1
SPRING * M.Arch. only	Final: October 1

STUDENT TYPE:	MEET THESE ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS:
FIRST YEAR	Both of these conditions must be met: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. ACT minimum 24 / SAT minimum 1090 if taken before February 2016 (or SAT minimum 1160 if taken after February 2016)2. Cumulative GPA of 3.2 or higher
CHANGE OF SCHOOL RE-ADMIT TRANSFER	Cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher from all college or university coursework, including KU. Students with less than 24 hours of college level credit will have to submit a high school transcript and will also be evaluated by the first year requirements.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

In order to complete the application process and be eligible for admission, you must provide the following documents:

APPLICATION

Freshman, Transfer, and Re-Admit Students

Complete the on-line application by going to www.admissions.ku.edu and selecting the School of Architecture and Design and indicate the 5-year Master of Architecture or the 4-year B.S. Interior Architecture degree as a major on the application. This application will serve as both your application to KU and to the School of Architecture & Design. Submit the Architecture Interest Profile or the IA Interest Profile, which is part of the on-line application. If you did not initially apply to Architecture or if you applied by paper application, please submit the Architecture Interest Profile at: www.architecture.ku.edu/architecture-interest-profile or the IAD Interest Profile at: www.arcd.ku.iad-interest-profile.

Freshmen

Upload your high school transcript when you apply on-line or fill out the self-reported curriculum section of the application.

High School Preparation for Architecture and Interior Architecture & Design Programs

The following courses are recommended for adequate preparation for admission :

- 3 or more years of math;
- 3 or more years of natural science, including physics;
- 3 or more art (including drawing) classes. Art/drawing classes are preferred over additional drafting or technical courses (one semester of drafting is adequate);
- 2 or more years of foreign language.

Transfer Students

Kansas/Missouri Reciprocity Agreement

The KANSAS/MISSOURI RECIPROCITY AGREEMENT allows for a limited number of legal residents from Missouri to pay Kansas resident fees. The student must be a U.S. Citizen or Permanent Resident. The present agreement gives highest priority to continuing students. The number of eligible students is reviewed each semester and new students will be assigned vacated fee waivers as they become available. For the current academic year, all eligible students hold a waiver.
